**Midtown Crossing Offering Free Shuttle Service to Creighton-Nebraska Game,
TD Ameritrade Park Omaha Debut**

Omaha, Neb. – Midtown Crossing's free event shuttle will run to TD Ameritrade Park Omaha this evening for the stadium's grand debut, a match-up between the Creighton Bluejays and the Nebraska Cornhuskers.

"It's our way of treating fans to less hassle during a historic night for baseball in Omaha," said Molly Skold, Marketing Director for East Campus Realty, LLC, the Mutual of Omaha subsidiary that owns Midtown Crossing.

Fans are encouraged to park in one of Midtown Crossing's two garages (first three hours free) and pick up the shuttle from 31st Ave. and Farnam St. near the Metro bus stop.

* Game time this evening is 6:30 p.m. Shuttle service begins at 4:30 p.m. and ends 90 minutes after the final out.

* Two shuttle busses will run continuous loops from Midtown Crossing to TD Ameritrade Park Omaha approximately every 15-30 minutes. (These specially-designated shuttles will **only** stop at Midtown Crossing and TD Ameritrade Park Omaha this evening.)

* There may be delays due to traffic so fans are encouraged to arrive early!

Parking:

Midtown Crossing offers convenient and secure parking for more than 3,000 vehicles. Two parking garages are easily accessible from 33rd, Farnam and Harney Streets. In both garages, the first three hours are free, and visitors pay only \$1 for each hour thereafter (with a daily maximum fee of \$6).
