AGREEMENT AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY
You Must Complete to Skate (One Per Participant)

Activity: Skating at the Rink at Midtown Crossing

The Participating Skater ("Participant"), being nineteen (19) years or older, or Participant's parent or legal guardian on behalf of minor children under the age of nineteen (19), understands, acknowledges, and agrees that skating is an inherently dangerous and physically demanding activity. Participant understands the risks of injury involved in participating in this activity and has voluntarily agreed to assume those risks while skating at the Rink at Midtown Crossing (the "Activity").

Participant hereby releases and forever waives and discharges East Campus Realty, LLC and The Salvation Army, collectively the organizers ("Organizers"), and their respective parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, employees, volunteers, officers, agents, representatives, successors and/or assigns of and from all responsibility for any and all rights, claims, actions, causes of action, demands, damages, costs, expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees) or judgments, losses, injuries, including bodily injury (including death), property damage, medical expenses, liabilities, and legal costs or other compensation whatsoever, whether known or unknown, that Participant now has or may hereafter accrue arising out of or related to participation in the Activity.

Participant assumes full responsibility for, and agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless Organizers and their respective parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, employees, volunteers, officers, agents, representatives, successors and/or assigns against any and all loss, including bodily injury (including death), property damage or loss, judgments, damages, costs, expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees) that may be directly or indirectly related to any claim, demand or cause of action arising out of or related to participation in the Activity.

Participant agrees to abide by the "Code of Skater Responsibility," as posted within the Rink at Midtown Crossing, and agrees to follow the instructions of the operating staff and security personnel while engaging in the Activity. Failure to follow the instructions of the operating staff and security personnel or to follow any of the requirements outlined in the "Code of Skater Responsibility" will result in the termination of Participant's use of the Rink, the rental skates, and the surrounding areas without a refund.

Participant permits Organizers, and their respective parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, employees, volunteers, officers, agents, representatives, successors and/or assigns to use any photographs, videotapes, recording or any other records taken while Participant engages in the Activity for publicity, advertising, or any other legitimate purpose, without compensation to the Participant.

Participant enters into this agreement freely and of his/her own accord. No assurance, promise, statement or representation has been made by Organizers to induce Participant to enter into this agreement.

Participant has read and fully understands the terms and conditions of this agreement and accepts all terms and conditions as specified herein. Participant is signing this document on his/her own behalf and on behalf of any minor children allowed by Participant to participate in the Activity.

RULES

- No fast skating, unnecessary roughness, or weaving through other skaters
- No pushing, shoving, running or horseplay
- No food or drinks on the Rink or on the railings
- No use of tobacco within the Rink area
- No one under the influence of drugs or alcohol is allowed on the Rink
- No foul language
- No sitting or climbing on the railings
- No one on the Rink without skates
- No carrying of children or secondary items such as phones, cameras, handbags, etc. while skating
- All skaters six (6) years of age and younger must wear a helmet
- No more than two (2) people may skate together (i.e., holding hands, forming trains, etc.)
- Skaters must keep moving in the direction of the flow
- Skaters and visitors must comply with all directions and instructions of the Rink management and security
- Exits must be kept clear at all times
- Organizers are not responsible for any personal items stolen or left within or around the Rink

Please make use of our Rink an enjoyable experience for all. Persons failing to observe these Rules will be asked to leave the premises with no refund.
